



PARENT AGREEMENT

I agree to:

- bring our child on time to the music program, and pick them up on time.

(I will ask them what happens at the classes and express my interest)

- attend the class with my child (when I am able) so that I can become familiar with the musical exercises and reinforce them at home.
- be positive and encouraging with regard to my child's musical skills
- share my love of music with my child and share my feelings about music with them.

(If possible take your child to live musical events)

- be ready to rent or purchase musical instruments in the future that may be necessary for my child's continuing musical development.
- encourage my children to practice their instrument at home and make the time to listen to them play.
- express a continuing commitment to my child's musical education through loving encouragement of their skills and practicing. Help them keep their commitment to practice their instrument.
- make time to attend any of my child's musical performances.

GREAT PARENTS PLEDGE:

1. Read or talk 20 minutes a day with your child
2. Partner with your child's teacher
3. Volunteer at your child's school
